Inspiration Guide



1. GATHER: The materials you will require are 1 base board, carbon paper, design template, paint (acrylic), adhesive, newspapers and a paint brush.



cut newspaper. Place the hook side of base board down. Work on the side of base board that does not have hooks. Place design template over the board edge-to-edge, and slip the carbon paper in between the board and template.



3. SECURE: Secure the design template to fit the size of the board. TIP - Use paper binder clip/s to secure the board, carbon paper and design template in place.



4. TRACE: Use a pencil to trace the lines of the design template. Apply firm pressure and stick to the lines.



5. PAINT: Remove the design template and carbon sheet. Paint around the traced shapes and the rest of the board.




6. GLUE: Carefully stick the Kattoos Terracotta Bricks with the adhesive over the traced shapes, as shown above. Let dry for at least 15 minutes.



7. REPEAT: Repeat steps 1 to 6 using the 2nd base board for the 2nd half of the banyan tree.



8. DISPLAY: Hang your completed artwork on a wall, with the hooks already provided on the back of the boards.



NOTE: Due to natural property of terracotta:

Keep the artwork away from water at all times. Make sure the wall used for display is not damp.

Over time some bricks may fall away. Use the extra bricks provided in the pack to replace these, using any suitable adhesive.
